

Manuscript accepted

Manuscript data exported for archiving/indexing

Manuscript sent to copyeditor

- Article and issue workflow in ProduXion Manager
- Submission tasks in ProduXion Manager replaced workflow with e-mails and spreadsheets

inal versions typeset at vendor, sent to editors

Author proofs processed

Files and communication stored in one place


Proofs prepared by typesetters

- Efficient tracking of articles from acceptance to issue publication
- Reporting tools for analyzing performance

Corrections sent to vendor; Approval for publication

Metadata fetched from external systems Corresponding author informed about publication

Article Workflow




Export/Import Tasks

Manuscript data exported for archiving/indexing

Metadata fetched from external systems

- Export to FTP server, import from FTP server
- Automatically triggered by previous task/when production is initiated
- Milestone tasks, don't need due date
- Automatically transfer metadata/submission files to other publisherbased systems
- Include additional information into article metadata
- No manual assignment necessary



- Assigned to responsible person (author/editor/vendor)
- Have due date and automatic reminders
- Send assignment files to task recipient
- Export metadata to FTP server (when necessary)
- Provide task recipient with files and metadata (when necessary)
- Receive revised files
- Track article status
- No need to manually send out reminders

Notification Tasks


Author proofs processed

Corresponding author informed about publication

- Send notification letters to task recipient
- Can be automatically triggered by previous task
- If not sent automatically
 - ightarrow Template letters can be modified before sending
- Automatically inform authors about manuscript status
 - ightarrow No manual processing
- Request additional information from authors
 - ightarrow Tracked in correspondence history

Developing Workflow in ProduXion Manager

- Workflow configured by Post-Acceptance Editors
 - ightarrow Refining workflow with day-to-day user experience
 - ightarrow Eliminating author pain points
- Easy to modify, add/change/reorder tasks
- Manual processing reduced as much as possible
 - ightarrow Automatic task assignment
 - ightarrow Automatic production task reminders
- Integration of new developments possible
 - $\rightarrow\,$ Including information collected from authors via submission questions into articles
