


EM for Books

- New functionality under development specifically designed to improve book workflows
- New features being rolled out across upcoming releases
- o Features being planned for release in 13.0, 13.1 and 14.0
- Further development being planned to refine workflow and user interface



General Books Workflow

- Existing functionality supported much of the desired books workflow
 - Preselected Article Types for Invited Workflow
 - Proposals being linked to multiple solicited submissions
 - The ability to construct a Table of Contents using a Schedule Group
- However, in order to facilitate the envisioned books workflow additional development was necessary


- Schedule Groups are enhanced:
 - Allows capture and storage of metadata specific to books (e.g. Book Title, multiple ISBNs, Edition)
 - Association of Units with the appropriate Book Product (on creation of the Units within the system), to streamline workflow
 - Preliminary assignment of Chapters to Units (and books) prior to submission of the Chapter to assist with workflow management

- Two Schedule Group Families introduced
 - Issue (existing SG functionality) and Book (new SG functionality)
 - Book family incorporates new Book specific metadata fields
 - Some Book metadata will flow down into Proposals attached to a Schedule Group



- Proposals enhanced:
 - New Book-related Proposal Type
 - Access to new Books-specific metadata fields



 Books metadata pulled down to Proposal from Schedule Group

- Proposal can now be assigned to Schedule Groups
 - Schedule Group is selected when initiating Proposal



 When Book-related Proposal Type is used existing Book Family Schedule Groups appear in drop-down menu


- In Book workflows the content to be created by Authors often is a known quantity with a title determined by the publisher
- In the past Editors might include the title in the invitation letter to the Author and rely on them to enter it manually

- In 13.0 configurations can be made to allow title values to be defined by an Editor when soliciting an Author, includes:
 - Full Title
 - Secondary Full Title

- Short Title
- Secondary Short Title



 The ability to predefine titles is determined by the settings of the parent submission from which the invitations originate



- The ability to enter one of the four possible title values is determined by the settings of the child submission
 - If the Article Type is preselected its settings will be used to display the fields and their limits

 Depending on configurations these titles may initially locked or unlocked for editing by Authors



 Editors will have the option to alter the default lock state on a case by case basis

- The recruitment of Authors to write for a book is primarily based on relationship building, calling in favors, cajoling, and strong arming
- o Publishers typically have a list of Authors who are willing to write a chapter or section of a book prepared before they are ready to begin using a system to build a Table of Contents populated with the individual sections of a Book Product
- Hundreds of Authors may contribute to a book, making searching for, registering, and inviting them a long, monotonous task


 Editorial Manager 13.0 introduces the ability to upload a list of Authors to solicit, instead of searching for each individual

 Allows Editors to quickly select Authors whether or not they have existing EM accounts

- A comma separated or tab-delimited list of Authors may be uploaded by an Editor
- Authors in the list will be matched to existing EM accounts when possible and be proxy registered when not
 - Incomplete data is filtered out of the import
- In addition to Author information the uploaded file may contain a predefined title for the requested work and notes about the assignment

 Editors simply upload a file, preview the information to be imported and proceed



Assign Authors

- Coming in EM 13.1 Authors will be able to receive assignments in addition to invitations
- Enables workflows where an Author can submit a solicited submission without having to accept an invitation
- In many book-related workflows the Authors have already been cajoled by an Editor/Lead Author into accepting work, this eliminates the confusion of having to agree again

Assign Authors



Assign Authors

- Properly permissioned Editors will have access to an assign option when selecting Authors
 - Configurations allow Editors to access either option individually or both
- Compatible with Author List File upload process
 - Authors in same file can be selected for both invitation and assignment

- Proposals (Units) are tracked in EM using the Proposal Manuscript Number, invited submissions are tracked using their individual Manuscript Numbers
- The automated manuscript numbering functionality has been enhanced to create a clear link between the Proposal and submission, as well as between the related submissions


 A format for invited submission Manuscript Numbers is configured as part of the Proposal settings

Invited Submission Manuscript Number Format:


Automatically Assign Customized Manuscript Number for Invited Submissions [Prefix.IncrementingNumber]
 Include Proposal Manuscript Number [Prefix.ProposalManuscriptNumber.IncrementingNumber]

Select 'Automatically Assign Customized Manuscript Number for Invited Submissions' to allow Editors to enter a prefix and incrementing number to be used for the invited submissions' manuscript numbers when the Proposal is initiated. To further include the Proposal Manuscript Number within the invited submissions' manuscript numbers, select 'Include Proposal Manuscript Number'. The Proposal's manuscript number can only be included if 'Automatically Assign Manuscript Number for Invited Submissions' is selected. If neither option is selected, the publication's manuscript numbering format is used.

 Format options include a prefix, incrementing number, as well as the option to include the Proposal's Manuscript Number



 Editors will set the prefix and starting number, as well as the minimum number of digits in the starting number, when initiating a Proposal



 A preview of the manuscript number will be available to Editors prior to creating the Proposal

Possible Future Enhancements

- Book-focused terminology interface (in process), including merge fields and reports.
- Create the ability to build a book TOC with multiple levels (e.g., volumes, units, sections, chapters) Items can be moved around.
- Allow "Production Tasks" to be assigned to chapters, while keeping those chapters out of the production workflow (e.g., collecting contributor agreements, collecting additional content, working with permissions, etc.).
- Restrict access to schedule groups (e.g., freelancer should only be able to access the schedule group they are working with).
- Modify import/ingest and export/transmittal functions to exchange data with other book systems (e.g., financial, inventory, collateral).
