Why use Transfer functionality?

Cascading Workflow!

- Prevents rejection of papers due to topic
- Seamless resubmission process for authors
- Retention of original data and source files



Types of Transfers

There are two basic types of Transfers:

Editorial Transfer

RESECTED

Reject and Transfer

Both can be used to transfer to EM and non-EM sites.

Types of Transfers

Editorial Transfers

Transfer is initiated by the Editorial Office in cases where topic suitability is quickly identified (meaning the submission has not been assigned to an editor).

Types of Transfers

Reject and Transfer

Transfer is initiated by the Editor at the time of decision, either before or after peer review.

How Editorial Transfers work

Set Final Disposition "The value of transferring MSs"

Setting the final disposition completes the peer-review process. You may only set a Final Disposition of "Accept" or "Reject" after you notify the author of the editor's decision.


Setting a Final Disposition of "Accept" may initiate production or trigger transmittal of data to the publisher if your publication is configured to do this. If you choose a Final Disposition of "Transfer" a list of possible recipients will display. After you have made your choice, you will have an opportunity to customize letters regarding the transfer. When this process is complete, the submission will be transferred.



What information transfers?

EM to EM Transfer:

- Corresponding Author information
 - EM-to-EM will link to People record or create new record
- Co-Authors
 - Including verification status
- Submission metadata entered by Author
 - e.g. Title, Abstract, Keywords

What information transfers?

Submission metadata

 Matching Article Type, Classifications, Category

Files

All files for all versions of the submission

Additional Information

- Matching Custom Submission Questions
- Reviews
- Decision Letter

What information transfers?

EM to Non-EM Transfer:

- Information is transferred via FTP
- All submission files
- XML file with submission metadata
- Receiving site must import the submission

Fun Transfer Facts!

 There are several merge fields associated with transfers:

Transfer Submission Merge Fields

The following merge fields are used when the "Reject and Transfer" feature is used. These merge fields can be used in the 'Notify Author' letter, the Editor Notification of Author Accepts Transfer letter (as noted), or the Author Transfer Reminder letters. These merge fields are:

- **%AGREE_TO_TRANSFER%** Inserts a hyperlink, which when clicked, fully logs the Author in and delivers him to the 'Transfer Submission to a Different Publication' page, where he can select the publication to which he wishes to have his paper transferred.
- **%DECLINE_TO_TRANSFER%** Inserts a hyperlink, which when clicked, delivers the Author to the 'Decline to Transfer Confirmation' page, and automatically sets the Final Disposition if the submission to 'Reject'.
- %TRANSFER_TARGETS% Inserts a list of all publications to which this submission can be transferred, along with links to these websites. The Author will be able to choose which of these sites she wishes to transfer her submission to when she agrees to the transfer.
- **%TRANSFER_OFFER_EXPIRATION_DATE%** Inserts the date by which an Author must agree to transfer the submission before a Final Disposition of 'Reject' is automatically set. This date is calculated at the time the Author is notified of the Decision based on the number of days configured on the 'Configure Cross-Publication Submission Transfer' page.
- **%ACTUAL_TRANSFER_PUBLICATION_TITLE%** Inserts the name of the Publication to which the submission has been transferred. For use in a letter configured for the 'Author Agrees to Transfer Submission' event.
- %AUTHOR_TRANSFER_REMIND_COUNT% Inserts the number of revision reminder letters that the Author has been sent for this submission/revision. For use in Author Reminder letters.
- %AUTHOR_TRANSFER_REMIND_DATE% Inserts the date that the last revision reminder letter was sent to the Author. For use in Author Reminder letters.
- **%TRANSFERRED_REVIEWS%** Inserts all eligible reviews for all versions of a transferred submission, similar to the way the information appears on the 'Transferred Information' page. Available for use in all letters associated with EM to EM Transfers (Portal and non-Portal). May be used in the 'Transfer Letter' that is deposited in the sending and receiving publication site, in letters sent to any Editor in the Editor Chain on the receiving site, and in Reviewer Invitations on the receiving site.
- %AGREE_TO_TRANSFER% Inserts a hyperlink, which when clicked, fully logs the Author in and delivers him to the 'Transfer Submission to a Different Publication' page, where he can select the publication to which he wishes to have his paper transferred.
- **%DECLINE_TO_TRANSFER%** Inserts a hyperlink, which when clicked, delivers the Author to the 'Decline to Transfer Confirmation' page, and automatically sets the Final Disposition if the submission to 'Reject'.
