




EM/PM for Books

- New functionality under development specifically designed to improve book workflows across Editorial Manager and ProduXion Manager
- New features being rolled out within upcoming releases
- Features being planned for release in 13.0, 13.1 and 14.0
- Further development being planned to refine workflow and user interface
- Requires activation PM must be activated and new PolicyManager setting 'Enable Book Processing' must be selected
- Suggested use EM/PM site dedicated to book processing

General Books Workflow

- Existing EM/PM functionality supports much of the desired books workflow
 - Preselected Article Types for Invited Workflow
 - Proposals being linked to multiple solicited submissions
 - The ability to construct a Table of Contents using a Schedule Group
- New features are added to support books processing

Schedule Group Enhancements

"Schedule Group" is a PM concept, in 12.2:

- Container for submissions (typically for an issue)
- Has Schedule Group level metadata + a table of contents

In 13.0:

- Schedule Groups separated into "Families"
 - Issue (existing SG functionality) and Book (new SG functionality)
 - Book family has new metadata fields specific to books (e.g. Book Title, multiple ISBNs, Edition)
 - Schedule Groups can be automatically created in the 'Book' family when added



- Proposal Article Types can now be designated as book-related
- Proposals (Unit) can be associated with Schedule Group (Book) when Proposal is initiated
 - Streamlines workflow; Proposals are shown as "headers" in the Schedule Group TOC
- Book metadata is displayed on *Initiate Proposal* page, *View Related Submissions* page


Proposal/Invited Submissions Enhancements

- Invited submissions also have book-related metadata fields available
- New "Default Book" Details page available for Proposals and Submissions
 - Can be customized
- Invited Submissions (Chapters) from each Proposal (Unit) are pre-assigned to Schedule Group (Book), if Proposal is assigned to Schedule Group
 - Occurs when chapter is submitted
 - Chapters shown in new 'Pre-selected Submissions' grid on Schedule Group Details pages
 - New "Pre-selected Schedule Group" criterion added to Search Submissions
 - Assists with workflow management

 Editor chooses a Book Schedule Group from the dropdown when Initiating Proposal



 Some Book metadata (from Schedule Group) visible on Initiate Proposal page




- Other Book-related metadata available for entry on Initiate Proposal page (similar fields as for Book Schedule Group level)
- Intended to hold counts for the Proposal (Unit) level

 Proposal "Unit I" shown in Schedule Group TOC as a header, with its book metadata




Proposal/Invited Submissions Enhancements

- Editor invites Authors Thomas Marshall and Anthony Author for Chapter 1 and Chapter 2
- Authors submit their invited Chapters
- Editor adds book metadata on Details page
- Submissions shown on View Related Submissions page with Book Metadata
- Submissions shown in Pre-selected Submissions grid of Schedule Group

 Schedule Group metadata displayed, book metadata displayed for related invited submissions






TOC and Pre-selected Submissions grid

 When Production Initiated on Chapter 1, it automatically jumps into Schedule Group TOC and out of Pre-selected Submissions grid, under its related unit



Search Submissions


 "Pre-selected Schedule Group" added to Search Submissions criteria list for submissions




- In Book workflows the content to be created by Authors often is a known quantity with a title determined by the publisher
- In the past Editors might include the title in the invitation letter to the Author and rely on them to enter it manually

- In 13.0 configurations can be made to allow title values to be defined by an Editor when soliciting an Author, includes:
 - Full Title
 - Secondary Full Title

- Short Title
- Secondary Short Title



 The ability to predefine titles is determined by the Article Type settings of the parent submission from which the invitations originate




- The ability to enter one of the four possible title values is determined by the settings of the child submission
 - If the Article Type is preselected its settings will be used to display the fields and their limits

 Depending on configurations these titles may initially locked or unlocked for editing by Authors



 Editors will have the option to alter the default lock state on a case by case basis


 EM13.0 introduces the ability to upload a list of Authors to solicit, instead of searching for each individually




 Allows Editors to quickly select Authors whether or not they have existing EM accounts

- A comma separated or tab-delimited list of Authors may be uploaded by an Editor
 - Can be created using Excel or other spreadsheet software
- Authors in the list will be matched to existing EM accounts when possible and be proxy registered when not
 - Incomplete data is filtered out of the import
- In addition to Author information the uploaded file may contain a predefined title for the requested work, notes about the assignment, and the initial selection type for each Author

 Editors simply upload a file, preview the information to be imported and proceed











Predefined Full Title displayed in Author Candidates Grid (if present in ALF)...



- New "Language Pack" specific to books
- Ex. "Proposal" renamed "Project", "Author" renamed "Contributor"
- Must be enabled by Aries Client Services
- Intended to be site-wide


13.1 + 14.0 Books Features

- Assign Authors (13.1)
- Invited Submission Manuscript Numbering enhancements (13.1)
- BITS Production Task Transmittals and additional Book Metadata Fields (14.0)

Assign Authors

- Coming in EM 13.1 Authors will be able to receive assignments in addition to invitations
- Enables workflows where an Author can submit a solicited submission without having to accept an invitation
- New ActionManager events support separate default Author assignment letter templates for commentaries and Proposals

Assign Authors



Assign Authors

- Properly permissioned Editors will have access to an assign option when selecting Authors
 - Configurations allow Editors to access either option individually or both
- Compatible with Author List File upload process
 - Authors in same file can be selected for invitation or assignment
- Author assignments go directly to the My Accepted Invitations folder

Invited Submission Manuscript Numbering Enhancements

- Proposals (Units) are tracked in EM using the Proposal Manuscript Number, invited submissions are tracked using their individual Manuscript Numbers
- The automated manuscript numbering functionality has been enhanced to create a clear link between the Proposal and submission, as well as between the related submissions

 A format for invited submission Manuscript Numbers is configured as part of the Proposal Article Type settings


Invited Submission Manuscript Number Format:

- Use format configured on 'Set Manuscript Number Format' page
- Use Prefix + Incrementing Number entered on the 'Initiate Proposal' page


 Editors will set the invited submissions' prefix and starting number, as well as the minimum number of digits in the starting number, when initiating a Proposal

Author Response Due: A value of zero indicates the Response due date feature is not Number of Days Author has to Respond to Invitation being used. 0 Author Submission Due: A value of zero indicates the Submission due date feature is not Number of Days prior to Launch Date being used. - A preview of the Invited Submission manuscript number will be available to Editors prior to finalizing the Proposal
- Example: Prefix = Taylor.Unit1-2015.
- Starting Number = 1
- Minimum Number of Digits in Starting Number = 7



- Each invited submission will have the same Prefix
- The first invited submission will have the number 0000001
- The second invited submission will have the suffix 0000002



BITS 2.0

- Schedule Group and Production Task Transmittal Export Methods
- Based on the 'JATS' XML
- Includes Book-level and Book-part (unit/chapter) sections
- New fields added to Schedule Group Book metadata and written into BITS transmittal (along with existing book metadata fields)
 - Subtitle
 - Alt-title
 - Schedule Group DOI
 - Book ID
 - Copyright Statement, Copyright Year, Copyright Holder
