EM Ingest Element Mapping Enhancement

Publications can use the EM Ingest Service to allow submission partners (e.g., independent manuscript service providers or publisher-branded portals) to send submissions to a publication's EM site on behalf of authors.

This enhancement expands the Ingest XML payload to include identifiers for Article Types, Questionnaires, and Submission Item Types for use in mapping between publication-specific definitions and the elements included in the ingested submission. The identifiers used are the unique IDs (primary keys) for the Article Types [DCATEGOR], Questionnaire Maps [CUSTOM_SUBMISSION_QUESTIONNAIRE_MAP], and Submission Item Types [DFILETYPE] tables, which identify elements defined by the publication.

These identifiers can be used in addition to Custom Metadata IDs to ensure correct mapping.

TO CONFIGURE:

EM Ingest Service must be enabled by your Aries Account Coordinator.

Reporting Enhancements

Changes to Table and Field Names in Enterprise Analytics Reporting

As part of the ongoing work to make naming clearer and more consistent in reporting tools and Database Content Help popups, the tables and fields listed below have been renamed. New table names will appear in the Choose View or Table drop-down list in EAR reports. New field names will appear in the Field drop-down list in EAR reports. These names will also populate the Description text box when a user creates a new report or adds the field to an existing report. Any user-entered text in the Description text box will be retained when a user edits an existing report.

Three tables have been renamed:

- Additional Schedule Group Detail Field Values [ADDITIONAL_SCHEDULE_GROUP_DETAILS_VALUES]: Previously, this table was named “Additional Schedule Group Details Values.”
- Additional Schedule Group Detail Fields [ADDITIONAL_SCHEDULE_GROUP_DETAILS_FIELDS]: Previously, this table was named “Additional Schedule Group Details Fields.”
- Legacy Manuscript Field Values [LEGACY_MANUSCRIPT_VALUES]: Previously, this table was named “Legacy Manuscript Values.”

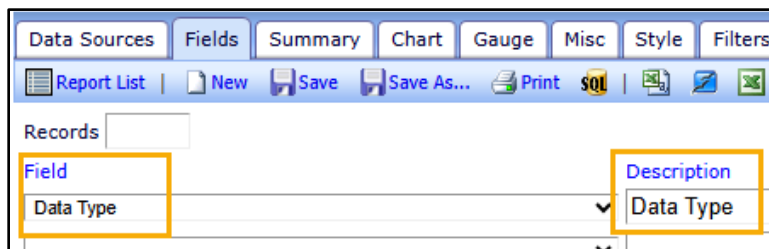

- Transmittal Form Tracking Info ID [TF_TRANSMITTAL_TRACKING.ID]: Previously, this field was named “Unique Primary key.”

New names will appear in the Field drop-down list in EAR. New names will populate the Description text box when the field is added to a new or existing report (top image). User-entered Description text is not overwritten in existing reports.



These changes also apply to General Data Export. New table names appear in the Choose Table drop-down list. New field names appear in the Criterion drop-down list on the General Data Export page where a user defines the criteria for the data export and as column headers on the results page.

TO CONFIGURE:

No configuration is necessary. Users with related reporting permissions will see the updated field names.

General Data Export Changes to Field Names

As part of an initiative to provide consistency of naming and more accurate descriptions of data displayed, the following changes have been made. These changes apply only to General Data Export (the fields do not appear in Enterprise Analytics Reporting).

Table name change

This new table name appears in the drop-down list on the main General Data Export page where a user makes a table selection.

- AMD_FLAG_LINK has been renamed “Additional Manuscript Detail Fields to Custom Flag Links” (was “Custom Flag to Additional MS Details Links”).

Field name changes

These new field names appear in the Criterion drop-down list on the General Data Export page where a user defines the criteria for the data export. These names also appear as column headers on the results page. New field names and associated database names are listed below.

Two fields in the Additional Manuscript Detail Fields to Custom Flag Links table have been renamed:

- AMD Field to Custom Flag Link ID [AMD_FLAG_LINK.AMD_LINKED_FLAG_ID]
- Configured Custom Flag ID [AMD_FLAG_LINK.CUSTOM_FLAG_CONFIG_ID]

One field in the Additional Schedule Group Detail Fields to Custom Flag Links table has been renamed:

- ASGD Field to Custom Flag Link ID [ASGD_FLAG_LINK.ASGD_FLAG_LINK_ID]

One field in the Login Attempts table has been renamed:
