


WHAT IS ORCID?

- ✓ ORCID is an open, not-for-profit organization that serves the research community by collaborating and innovating with organizations like yours
- ✓ We provide researchers with a unique identifier, an ORCID iD, that reliably and clearly connects them with their research contributions and affiliations
- ✓ Hundreds of systems have now integrated ORCID iDs from grant application and manuscript submission to CRIS and other research information management systems, and more!

MAKING OUR DREAM A REALITY

Imagine if your authors could sign into their manuscript submission system of the journal they are submitting to using their ORCID credentials...

And their iD was then automatically included in their article's metadata...

And that information was used to automatically update their ORCID record with the DOI for the published article...

Then imagine that information flowing back into your systems AND all the other ORCID-embedded systems your author uses...

and DataCite to update your ORCID profile













and you add your ORCID to your paper or dataset submission

when your publication gets a DOI, your ORCID profile will get updated







AUTOMATICALLY!

ORCID AUTO-UPDATE

- Enables researchers to authorize automatic updates to their ORCID record
- Currently used by Crossref and DataCite
- Crossref: during submission process
 - 150,000 records, 300,000 works updated
- DataCite: independent of submission process
 - 25,000 records, 50,000 works updated






HOW IT WORKS: ORGANIZATIONS

- Collect authenticated ORCID iDs from authors
- **Include** iDs in content registered with Crossref and DataCite
 - Provenance and source are essential
- Display iDs in published article
- Connect iDs to author's ORCID record when DOI is created
 - Crossref/DataCite auto-update
- Synchronize data with your own systems





HOW IT WORKS: RESEARCHERS

- Sign up for an ORCID iD
- Authenticate ORCID iD when prompted during submission (Crossref)
- Authorize Crossref/DataCite to read/update record
 - One time only authorization
- **Select** preferred visibility setting for works



MAKING OUR DREAM A REALITY

Now imagine that your peer reviewers could sign in to review an article using their ORCID credentials...

And that information was captured with their review so they could authorize you to automatically connect their review activity to their ORCID record...


What if that information could also flow to and from all the other ORCID-embedded systems your reviewers use...

ORCID PEER REVIEW FUNCTIONALITY

- Based on CASRAI Peer Review Services Dictionary
- Suitable for all types of peer review
- Review activities are added by third party, not researcher
- Enables organizations to recognize peer review activities
- Allows researchers to keep track of their own reviews

135,000+ reviews added to ORCID records to date






HOW IT WORKS: ORGANIZATIONS

- Collect reviewers' iDs and biographical information
- Display reviewers' iDs
- Connect review activity data to reviewers' ORCID records
- Synchronize your system's data with reviewers' records

Only available with API 2.0

HOW IT WORKS: RESEARCHERS

- Sign up for an ORCID iD
- Authenticate ORCID iD when prompted
- Authorize reviewing organization to read/update record
- Select preferred visibility setting for review data



MAKING OUR DREAM A REALITY

Finally, imagine a world where your book authors could sign into your books submission system using their ORCID credentials...

And their ORCID iD was then carried through the production process and included in the metadata for the chapter/book...

Enabling it to be included in ONIX feeds and other sales and marketing data...

ORCID IN BOOKS WORKFLOW: BENEFITS

- Matching authors across book and journal systems
- Simplifying sign-on into systems
- Improved discovery, citation, and marketing
- Benefits in peer review
- Empowering semantic systems



ORCID IN BOOKS WORKFLOW: CHALLENGES

- Differences between book and journal workflows
 - And between different types of books workflows
- Lack of awareness of ORCID in key disciplines
- Dealing with backlist titles
- Lack of ORCID integration in books systems (but...)



WORKFLOW: RECOMMENDATIONS

- Focus on author touchpoints and title management systems
- Prioritize publishers already using ORCID for journals and/or that publish conference proceedings, major reference works
- Collaborate with MLA Commons and others to build awareness/trust
- Develop/expand partnerships with JSTOR, OCLC, ISNI etc
- Share success stories!










COLLECT & CONNECT GOALS

- Clarify goals and expectations across sectors
- Standardize and improve the user experience
- Improve understanding and trust in connections made between ORCID and other identifiers
- Increase efficiency and quality of integrations
- Help achieve the ORCID vision through a community approach







- ✓ Collect and store **authenticated** iDs and provenance (source)
- ✓ Provide an ORCID-branded button for collecting iDs
- Explain benefits of having an iD for your researchers
- Explain the benefits of including ORCID iDs at your site







- ✓ Include ORCID iDs in metadata
- Display the iD with the iD icon, following ORCID guidelines
- Use the member logo when describing your organization's connection with ORCID
- Explain why you collect iDs





CONNECT!

- ✓ Request permissions to write to/update the user's ORCID record to assert affiliation, works, and more (with provenance) AND/OR
- Ingest information from ORCID records to auto-populate forms

AND

• Explain the benefits of your system connections with ORCID



SYNCHRONIZE!



- Create bidirectional information flow (synchronization) between ORCID and your system AND/OR
- Automatically update ORCID records AND/OR
- Create a search & link wizard

AND

• In all cases, explain benefits to individual
